Topic 17 – Kindness

Learning Intention Hey, why this lesson?

That kindness is simply 'less self' more others!



Jesus was the epitome of kindness eg helping children, sick etc. The intention is to be inspired by his actions then explore and discover how we discover that kindness creates more kindness.

Hint: That kindness is contagious and brings joy to ALL.

Scripture

"... for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and gave me clothing ..."

- Matthew 25:35-36, 40

Virtues

- selflessness more concerned with welfare of others than yourself
- compassion demonstrate sympathy and concern for others
- empathy walk in others' shoes, share others' feelings

We see many people who are homeless but we are often in a quandary of whether to help. Discuss why – ask the students to be honest and to try and use the virtue 'empathy' – walking in others' shoes e.g. dangerous, can't help everyone etc.

Warm Up Activity

The true meaning of 'Selfless'

- 1. If you have done Topic 10 the students may have already written a 'gratitude letter' if not go for it.
- 2. Now ask them what was
 - a) the reaction
 - b) how it made them feel?
- 3. Journal these discussions.

Main Activity

- 1. Ask the students to find a 'Good News' story rather than all the sad news we see on television/ media devices.

Connection Activity

Link the Scripture (Matt 25:35-36, 40) to the Golden Rule. Discuss with students in what ways the message is still relevant to us today in a world of poverty, injustice and unrest.

Reflection Activity

Dear Lord

Please give me the strength and the will-power to NOT think about myself so much. I need to remember to open my heart to those around me who struggle and who don't have the opportunities that I have been given. Let me strive to become selfless like you were when you were on earth. I ask for your help through Christ Our Lord. Amen

Before reflecting on these pages about kindness ask the students to write in their journal (page 76) the most beautiful act of kindness they have ever seen or heard about. How and why did it impact on them? Can they copy this action or try and reciprocate it?

Success Criteria

Students will be able to ...

- write down a 'virtue' that they feel best describes each of them in regard to kindness and explain why this virtue is important
- identify a 'Virtue' that they feel they need to work on or take up as a virtue
- plan and write a letter to someone who has shown them kindness
- research an individual or group that has displayed great kindness and then discuss the flow -on effect of this kindness
- discuss the kindnesses that Jesus displayed in His life here on earth.



Without a doubt one of the most powerful things a human can do for others is display kindness. Suggest students write about one of the three virtues and how they are going to take away this virtue to help others.
